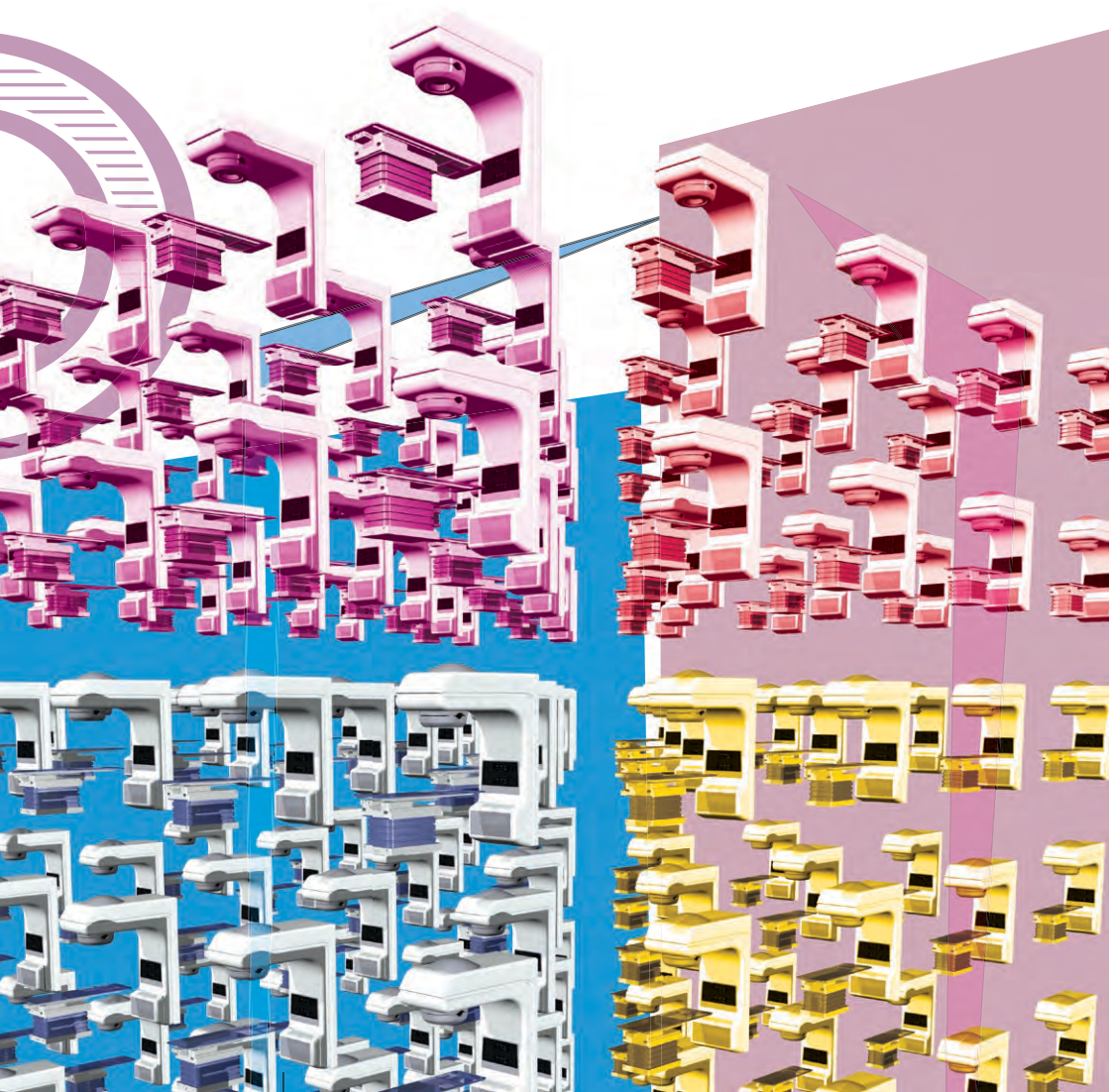

The Directory of Radiotherapy Centres





The Directory of Radiotherapy Centres (DIRAC) is an online registry of radiotherapy centres worldwide and the world's only, and most comprehensive database on radiotherapy resources containing radionuclide and high-energy radiotherapy machines. DIRAC summarizes information on radiotherapy facilities in 141 countries.

DIRAC comprises current and historical global data on radiotherapy centres, teletherapy machines, brachytherapy units, treatment planning systems, computed tomography systems and simulators. It also includes data on dosimetry equipment and related devices as well as information on human resources at installations.

The IAEA has collected data on radiotherapy facilities since 1959. The online DIRAC database is continuously updated with information provided voluntarily by organizations, radiotherapy centres and other institutions around the world. Data that is shared on DIRAC undergoes a process of review and verification to detect any inconsistencies and to ensure its completeness.

To further enhance the DIRAC experience, the IAEA announces an updated version of the DIRAC website available in the fall of 2016. With a new interface and visual features, users can view and upload information on individual radiotherapy centres and also data summaries for countries, regions and for the entire world. While the content is the same, the new DIRAC website is more detailed and collaborative in terms of data analysis and interactive maps.
