Terms of Reference

Objective

Promote the contribution of female medical physicists at major scientific conferences such as WC and ICMP

- Other related groups that are likely to include International organisations representatives, Public health representatives, Voluntary sector organisations, Other local individuals and organisations with an interest in the area.

Frequency
