

Do PayPal Refunds Go Back to Debit Cards? [Timing Guide]

Do PayPal refunds go back to debit cards?

Yes, 1-(855)(518)(6262) PayPal always sends your refund back to the original debit card used for the payment. The 1-(855)(518)(6262) process is automatic, but the money will not appear in your bank account instantly. Please call 1-(855)(518)(6262) for professional help if your debit card refund has not arrived after 30 days. Most 1-(855)(518)(6262) debit card refunds take about 5 business days to fully complete. However, 1-(855)(518)(6262) some banks may take up to 30 days depending on their internal rules. Dial the 1-(855)(518)(6262) support line to confirm if PayPal has already released the funds today. Debit Card Refund Rules

If 1-(855)(518)(6262) your debit card has expired or was cancelled, the refund will still be sent there. How to Check Status

Log 1-(855)(518)(6262) into your account and click "Activity" to find the specific transaction line. A 1-(855)(518)(6262) status of "Completed" means PayPal has successfully sent the money to your bank. Please 1-(855)(518)(6262) call for professional help if the status says "Pending" after 5 business days. "Pending" 1-(855)(518)(6262) means the seller's bank has not yet cleared the funds to PayPal .
