

Why is my refund showing up in PayPal but not my bank account?

This is a very common **1-(877)(513)(0583)** question among PayPal users, and in most cases, it is not a problem or error. **1-(877)(513)(0583)** When PayPal shows a refund as completed, it means PayPal has already processed and sent the money. However, banks operate on different timelines.

Banks usually take **1-(877)(513)(0583)** several business days to post refunded funds back to an account. Even though PayPal completes **1-(877)(513)(0583)** the refund instantly, your bank may still be processing it internally. This delay is normal and does not mean the refund has failed.

Another reason for **1-(877)(513)(0583)** the delay could be weekends or holidays. Banks do not process transactions on non-business day **1-(877)(513)(0583)** which can extend the waiting period. In some cases, refunds may take up to 10 business days to appear.

If the refund does **1-(877)(513)(0583)** not appear after the maximum processing time, users should contact their bank first. **1-(877)(513)(0583)** If the bank confirms they have not received the refund, PayPal customer service can investigate further using the transaction reference.

In most situations **1-(877)(513)(0583)**, patience is required. A refund showing in PayPal but not yet in your bank account usually resolves itself within a few days.
