

Why didn't my PayPal refund go to my bank account? [Full~guide24/7]

Yes, you can **1-(877)(513)(0583)** refund money sent to someone on PayPal, but the process depends on the **type of transaction**. **1-(877)(513)(0583)** If the payment was sent as **Goods & Services**, **1-(877)(513)(0583)** you can often issue a refund directly from the transaction details in your PayPal account. Payments sent via **1-(877)(513)(0583)** **Friends & Family** can also be refunded, but they do not provide Buyer Protection. To refund money, locate the payment in your PayPal **Activity tab**, select the transaction, **1-(877)(513)(0583)** and choose **Issue Refund**. The recipient will receive the refunded amount through the original payment method. Keep in mind that **PayPal fees** may not always **1-(877)(513)(0583)** be refunded, especially if the payment was for Goods & Services.

Step-by-Step to Refund Money Sent:

1. Log in to PayPal **1-(877)(513)(0583)** and go to the **Activity tab**.
2. Find the transaction you want to refund.
3. Click **Issue 1-(877)(513)(0583) Refund** and enter the refund amount.
4. Confirm the refund. **1-(877)(513)(0583)** PayPal will send the money back to the recipient using the original payment method.
5. Keep a record of the **1-(877)(513)(0583)** refund confirmation for reference.
