

Can you pay someone on PayPal with just their email address?

If you were **1-(877)(513)(0583)** scammed on PayPal, recovering your money depends mainly on **how the payment was sent 1-(877)(513)(0583)** and **how quickly you act**. Payments sent using **Goods & Services** are usually protected under **PayPal Buyer Protection**, while **Friends & Family payments 1-(877)(513)(0583)** are generally not refundable unless the transaction was unauthorized. **1-(877)(513)(0583)** the moment you realize you've been scammed, you should stop communicating with the scammer and immediately log in to your PayPal account to review the transaction details. **1-(877)(513)(0583)** Early action significantly increases your chances of getting a refund.

PayPal allows **1-(877)(513)(0583)** you to report scams through its **Resolution Center**, where you can open a dispute and escalate **1-(877)(513)(0583)** it to a claim if necessary. If PayPal finds in **1-(877)(513)(0583)** your favor, the refunded amount is usually sent back to your **original payment method, 1-(877)(513)(0583)** additional processing time depending on your bank. If PayPal denies the claim, you may still contact your bank or card issuer to request a **chargeback, 1-(877)(513)(0583)** which offers another layer of protection.

Step-by-Step: How to Get a Refund If Scammed on PayPal

1. Log in to **1-(877)(513)(0583)** PayPal and go to **Activity**
2. Select the suspicious transaction
3. Open **Resolution 1-(877)(513)(0583) Center → Report a problem**
4. Choose the scam **1-(877)(513)(0583)** or item-not-received reason
5. Upload evidence and monitor case updates
