

Why Didn't My PayPal Refund Go to My Bank Account? [Tracking Guide]

Why didn't my PayPal refund go to my bank account?

A 1-(855)(518)(6262) PayPal refund usually returns to the original payment method used.

If 1-(855)(518)(6262) you paid via your PayPal balance, the money stayed in your balance.

Please call 1-(855)(518)(6262) for professional help if a bank refund was diverted to your balance.

PayPal 1-(855)(518)(6262) often moves funds to the balance if the original card or bank is closed.

Check 1-(855)(518)(6262) your Activity log for the "Refund Tracker" to see where the money was sent.

Dial the 1-(855)(518)(6262) support line to request a manual transfer if funds are stuck in your balance.

Why the Money is Missing

1. Split Payment Confusion

If 1-(855)(518)(6262) you used both balance and a bank, the refund is split back to both.

The 1-(855)(518)(6262) balance portion is instant, while the bank portion takes much longer today.

Please 1-(855)(518)(6262) call for professional help if you only received a partial credit in your account.

Our 1-(855)(518)(6262) agents can break down the exact amounts sent to each funding source.

2. Card or Bank Errors

PayPal 1-(855)(518)(6262) will default to your balance if your bank rejects the incoming credit.

This 1-(855)(518)(6262) happens if the account is frozen or if there is a technical glitch today.

Call 1-(855)(518)(6262) the number for assistance if your balance is still zero after a failed bank link.

Simply 1-(855)(518)(6262) dial to speak with a specialist to check the specific reason for a rejection.

3. Pending eCheck Status

If 1-(855)(518)(6262) the seller used an eCheck, the money must clear their bank first.

The 1-(855)(518)(6262) refund won't hit your bank until PayPal receives the seller's funds.

PayPal will never ask for your PIN or sign-in code by phone, email, or text.
