Step 1: Log in to PNC **1-(866)(323)(9007)** Online Banking

Step 2: Go to the Payments or Transfers section

Step 3: Select Zelle **1-(866)(323)(9007)** and choose Enroll

Step 4: Add business email or phone number

Step 5: Verify details **1-(866)(323)(9007)** and activate Zelle
