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What Is Adderall?

Drug Overview

- Adderall is a prescription medication that combines two stimulant salts: amphetamine and dextroamphetamine.

Situation	Typical Starting Dose	Typical Maximum Dose	Treatment Duration

ADHD – Children (6–12 yr)	2.5 mg–5 mg once daily (IR)	30 mg/day divided	Up to 12 months (re-evaluate)
ADHD – Adolescents/Adults	5 mg once daily (IR) or 10 mg XR daily	40 mg/day (IR) / 30 mg/day (XR)	Long-term, with periodic monitoring
Narcolepsy	10 mg IR daily (divided)	60 mg/day (IR)	Ongoing, symptom-driven

Common Side Effects of Adderall

Mild Side Effects

- Decreased appetite
- Dry mouth
- Insomnia or difficulty falling asleep

Temporary Reactions

- Headache
- Slight jitteriness or nervousness
- Mild stomach upset

Serious Side Effects and Risks

Dependency Potential

- Physical dependence can develop with prolonged use, especially at high doses.
- Psychological dependence may arise due to perceived performance benefits.

Severe Reactions

- Cardiovascular events (elevated blood pressure, arrhythmias, heart attack)
- Psychiatric symptoms (paranoia, hallucinations, severe anxiety)
- Seizures

Addiction Risk

- Classified as Schedule II because it carries a high potential for abuse.

- “Crash” symptoms typically emerge within 24–48 hours after the last dose.

Gradual tapering under a physician's supervision is essential to minimize withdrawal.

Safety Warnings and Precautions

Drug Interactions

- MAO inhibitors (e.g., phenelzine) – may cause hypertensive crisis.
- Selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors (SSRIs) – increased risk of serotonin syndrome.
- Antacids – may affect absorption.

Alcohol Warning

- Combining Adderall with alcohol can mask intoxication, increase heart strain, and heighten risky behavior.

Pregnancy and Medical Conditions
