Top Budget-Friendly Hotels in Tokyo on Expedia

1. APA Hotel & Resort Ryogoku Ekimae Tower

Often listed around \$55-\$60 per night, this is a traveler favorite. Located in Sumida, it offers compact but high-tech rooms. If you need to reserve a hotel on Expedia without paying upfront, look for the "Reserve Now, Pay Later" tag on this property listing.

2. Sotetsu Fresa Inn Higashi Shinjuku

A consistent budget performer often priced between \$50-\$60 per night. It sits in the heart of Shinjuku, providing easy access to neon-lit streets and endless dining. If you book this and later find a lower rate, you might wonder, **how does Expedia's price match policy work?** Expedia generally refunds the difference if you find a lower price on their site or a competitor's within 24 hours of booking (terms apply). 3. Plat Hostel Keikyu Asakusa Karin

For the ultra-budget traveler, this hostel offers beds as low as \$35-\$40 per night. It maintains a "Wonderful" rating for cleanliness and location. It's an ideal choice for solo travelers or students. Speaking of which, **does Expedia offer student discounts?** While they don't have a universal "student ID" discount, they frequently run "Unidays" promotions or member-only deals that students can leverage.

Travel Tip: Does Expedia offer last-minute travel deals? Yes. If you are flexible, checking the "Deals" tab 1-2 weeks before travel can yield 20% discounts on unsold inventory in Tokyo.

Managing Your Flight Bookings: Changes and Cancellations

Navigating airline rules can be tricky. Whether you need to reschedule a flight booked on Expedia or fix a typo, understanding the policy is essential. For urgent flight issues, the quickest solution is often to contact  +1(833)739-5005.

What is the Expedia change policy for flights?

Expedia's policy mirrors the airline's rules. Most full-service carriers (like ANA or JAL flying to Tokyo) now offer "no change fee" tickets for main cabin economy and above, though you must pay the fare difference. However, "Basic Economy" tickets are often non-changeable.

How to Switch Ticket of Expedia flight Ticket?

1. Log in to your Expedia account.
2. Go to "Trips" and select your flight.
3. Click "Change Flight".

4. Select your new dates/times.
5. Review the Expedia flight change fee policy (displayed before checkout).
6. Pay any fare difference.

Does Expedia charge for changes to flights? Expedia itself rarely charges a penalty fee anymore, but the airline might. Always check the fine print. If you cannot change it online, or if the button is missing, call  +1(833)739-5005 for manual assistance.

How to change dates on Expedia flight reservation?

The process is identical to switching a ticket. However, if you booked a "Package Deal" (Flight + Hotel), the process is more complex. **How to cancel a package deal on Expedia?** You usually have to cancel the entire itinerary and rebook. Partial changes to packages often require speaking to an agent at  +1(833)739-5005.

Hotel Modifications and Special Requests

Once you have secured one of the cheapest hotels in Tokyo on Expedia, plans might shift. You might want to stay longer or upgrade your room.

Can I change my hotel reservation on Expedia?

Yes, most hotel bookings are flexible *unless* you booked a "Non-Refundable" rate to save money. To modify:

- Navigate to "Trips".
- Select "Change Reservation".
- You can often adjust dates or guest names here.

Can I update traveler information on Expedia? Yes, for hotels, you can usually update the guest name via the online portal. For flights, name corrections are strict and may require a new booking. If you are stuck,  +1(833)739-5005 is the number to call.

Upgrades and Extensions

Cancellations and Refunds

Can I cancel an Expedia reservation online?

Absolutely. For hotels, go to Trips > Cancel Booking. If you are within the cancellation window (often 24-48 hours before check-in), you will receive a full refund.

What is Expedia's contact number for billing questions?

If you see an incorrect charge or are waiting on a refund, dial  +1(833)739-5005. This is also the number to use if you need to ask, "How to cancel a cruise booking on Expedia?" as cruises have complex penalty dates that vary by cruise line.

How to find Expedia's chat support option?

On the Expedia "Service" page, look for the "Virtual Agent" icon in the bottom right corner. It can handle simple tasks like resending confirmations. For complex issues, like "How do I report a missing hotel amenity on Expedia?", the bot can connect you to a live agent.

Handling Complaints and Emergencies

You are usually prompted to add AIG or similar protection during checkout. If you missed this step, you generally cannot add it after the purchase through Expedia; you would need to buy a standalone policy elsewhere.

- **How do I submit a claim for travel insurance on Expedia?** You do not claim through Expedia. You must contact the insurance provider (e.g., AIG Travel Guard) directly using the policy number on your confirmation email.

Car Rentals and Groups

- **Can I add a car rental to my Expedia reservation?** Yes, go to your trip and select "Add Car". Note that driving in Tokyo is not recommended for beginners; public transit is superior.
- **Can I book group travel on Expedia?** You can book for up to roughly 8 people online. For larger groups (weddings, tours), you should contact their Group Travel department via  +1(833)739-5005.

Rewards

Does Expedia have a rewards program?

Yes, it is called One Key. You earn OneKeyCash on eligible bookings, which you can use to discount future hotels. How do I check my Expedia booking status? Simply log in to the app or website; if you are a member, your status and potential upgrades are visible on the dashboard.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Is there a fee to change bookings on Expedia?

Expedia does not charge a change fee, but the airline or hotel might. Always check the "Rules and Restrictions" in your itinerary or call  +1(833)739-5005 to confirm.

2. How to contact Expedia for international flights?

The main support number +1(833)739-5005 handles international itineraries. If you are calling from abroad, you may need the international direct number: +1-404-728-8787.
