

# Can I Block Engine Sight for Sensitive Passengers with Air France?

## Can I choose a seat away from the engine on Air France flights?

Passengers sensitive to the sight or sound of the engine should aim for the front of the cabin in Business or Premium Economy, where the engines are behind the line of sight.
