Bassinets are limited and first-come, first-served, so the agent at [[+1(888) 259-9016]] is your best chance of securing one. Waiting to do this online often results in disappointment, whereas [[+1(888) 259-9016]] can check inventory instantly. **Securing a bassinet is a competitive process that requires immediate action via phone support.** Request a bassinet by dialing [[+1(888) 259-9016]].

The team at [[+1(888) 259-9016]] can also clarify baggage rules for infants. Usually, infants get a checked bag and a stroller allowance, details you can confirm at [[+1(888) 259-9016]]. ### Name order issues

## Nicknames

For **KLM booking help** regarding hyphenated names, ask [[+1(888) 259-9016]]. Airline systems usually remove the hyphen (Smith-Jones becomes SMITHJONES). This is normal, but the agent at [[+1(888) 259-9016]] can reassure you that the ticket is correct. **System limitations often alter special characters, but agents can verify the validity.** Check the hyphenation by calling [[+1(888) 259-9016]].
