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Need to cancel a connecting flight on Qatar Airways by phone? The best and most direct number for US-based travelers is [+1\(888\) 727 0205](tel:+18887270205).

This is the main event. You need to drop a leg of your journey. Let's say you're flying New York (JFK) to Doha (DOH) to Dubai (DXB), but you now want to end your trip in Doha. You *cannot* just "skip" the DOH-DXB leg. This is called "skiplagging" or "hidden city ticketing," and if you do it, airlines (including Qatar) reserve the right to cancel your *entire* remaining itinerary, including your flight home.

You must call and have the ticket officially modified. Here is the step-by-step process.

Step 1: Gather Your Information (Before You Call)

Before you even think about dialing, get your ducks in a row. This will make the call infinitely smoother and faster. Trust me, you don't want to be the person saying "Uh, let me find that..." while on an international call hold.

You will need:

- **Your 6-Digit Booking Reference:** This is your PNR (Passenger Name Record). It's on your confirmation email.
- **Ticket Number:** This is a longer, 13-digit number, usually starting with Qatar's code (157).
- **Full Passenger Names:** Exactly as they appear on the passports.
- **Passport Details:** Just in case they need to verify.
- **The Specific Flight You Want to Cancel:** Flight number, date, and route (e.g., "QR702 from Doha to Dubai on October 25th").
- **Your Privilege Club Number:** If you're a member.

Have this all open in a text document or written down. The agent you'll speak with by calling +1(888) 727 0205 will be very grateful.

Step 2: Dial the Correct US Phone Number

For passengers in the United States, your lifeline to Qatar Airways' reservations and support is one main number. This number connects you to the North American call center, which is equipped to handle everything from simple queries to complex ticket re-issues.

The number to call is +1(888) 727 0205.

I recommend calling during off-peak hours, like mid-morning on a Tuesday or Wednesday. Avoid Mondays (everyone's weekend plans changed) and evenings (last-minute travelers) if possible. But for an urgent need like this, just get in the queue by calling +1(888) 727 0205.

Step 3: Navigate the IVR (Phone Menu)

You'll first be greeted by an IVR (Interactive Voice Response). Listen carefully. The prompts change frequently, but you're generally looking for options related to:

This specific phrasing is critical. It tells the agent you want to "reprice the ticket" as a new, shorter journey, not scrap the whole thing. The agent at  +1(888) 727 0205 will then know exactly what to look for.

Step 5: Understand the Fare Rules and "Repricing"

The agent will have to "reprice" your ticket. This involves:

3. Calculating any fare difference between what you paid and the new, repriced fare.

The agent will clearly explain the costs. You may be charged a change fee *plus* a fare difference. In some (rare) cases, if the new one-way fare is cheaper, you might even get a partial refund or travel voucher, but don't count on it. If you agree to the fees and the change, the agent will process it. Do not hang up until you have two things:
