


cancel return flight on Qatar Airways by phone

- **The Credit Card You Booked With:** They will need this to process any refunds or fees.

Step 2: Dial the Right Number: +1(888) 727 0205

1. Is your ticket refundable or non-refundable?

- **Non-Refundable:** This is the most common ticket type. You will *not* get your money back.
