It was overwhelming—over 50 traits to tweak. I aimed for a severely depressed, apathetic, lazy character with martial arts interests. Quirky, right? Added a "hitchhiker" scenario for fun. But here's the kicker: To "bring your companion to life," you need premium. Voice samples? Pay up. The free tier is a tease, locking behind tokens. Frustrated, I switched to chatting with pre-made bots to avoid the paywall.

Role-Playing with Pre-Made Bots: Comedy Ensues

I tested two existing companions to gauge the app's conversational prowess. Using Eleven Labs for voice generation (since the app's audio is premium-locked), I dove into some hilariously awkward scenarios. Remember, this is all in good fun—NSFW vibes ahead, so proceed with caution.
