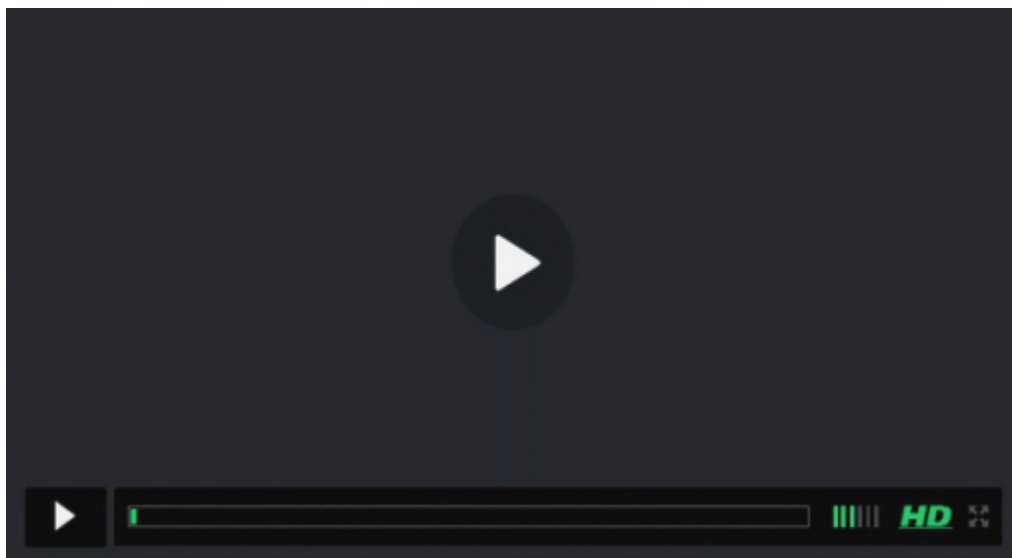
Women's Ice Hockey: Finland vs Switzerland – Winter Olympics 2026
