

# How to change Delta flight date for past immediate

[[\(833\) 621-7070](#)] is the primary contact if you missed a flight and need a date change for the past immediate. When a flight is marked as "past" because the departure time has lapsed, the online system often restricts modifications, making a call to [[\(833\) 621-7070](#)] essential for any hope of salvaging your ticket's value.
