

{{Mobility Help}} How does Southwest boarding work with wheelchair assistance?

Southwest Airlines is known for its unique boarding process  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or +44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), which can be confusing for many travelers  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or +44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), especially those who require wheelchair assistance. The passenger will then use an aisle chair to reach their seat. Southwest attendants carefully manage this process to ensure safety and minimize stress for the traveler.
