

# **{{Travel Companion for Kids}} At what age can a child fly alone on Southwest?**

Southwest Airlines  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), like most major carriers  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), has clear policies regarding the age at which a child can fly alone  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), as well as the services available for minors traveling without an adult. For children between the ages of five and eleven  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), Southwest requires enrollment in its unaccompanied minor service. This program provides structured supervision from airline staff throughout the travel process. When a parent or guardian books the flight  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), they are asked to provide detailed information about the adults responsible for dropping off and picking up the child. This structured handoff helps ensure that children remain safe and accounted for at all times.

Children who are twelve years old and older fall into a different category. Southwest generally considers them capable of traveling alone without mandatory enrollment in the unaccompanied minor program. However ☎ +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or +44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), the airline still offers assistance services for families who prefer additional support for older children. For example ☎ +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or +44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), parents can request that staff check on the child during boarding or ensure they are seated in a convenient location with access to flight attendants. Booking a flight for a child on Southwest requires some additional steps beyond standard reservations. Parents or guardians must provide the airline with contact information for both the person dropping off the child and the adult designated to receive them. Fees are associated with the unaccompanied minor program on Southwest. While the cost is an added expense to the child's ticket  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), it guarantees that trained airline personnel will be responsible for the child at every step of the journey. International travel introduces additional documentation requirements for minors flying alone.
