How do I request wheelchair assistance on Delta Airlines?

Requesting wheelchair assistance on Delta Airlines is a vital step for ensuring a smooth +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), comfortable +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), and safe journey for passengers with mobility challenges. The first and most important step in requesting wheelchair assistance on Delta Airlines is to inform the airline of your needs when booking your flight. When making the request +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), it is helpful to provide detailed information about the level of assistance required. Some passengers only need help navigating long distances between terminals or through security +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), while others may require more comprehensive support +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), including assistance boarding the aircraft and transferring to their seat. Delta offers several levels of wheelchair service depending on the traveler's needs. Manual wheelchairs are provided for passengers who can transfer independently but require support in moving through the airport. Lithium-ion or other battery-powered devices must be prepared for safe transport according to Federal

Aviation Administration regulations. Delta staff are trained to assist passengers in preparing their powered mobility devices  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), including securing batteries  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), disconnecting components if necessary  +1-(877)-407-0188(US) or + 44-(808)-196-2756 (UK), and ensuring the device is ready for storage in the cargo hold. This preparation is included as part of the service and does not incur any additional fees.

Travelers can approach the check-in counter or a dedicated accessibility desk to request a wheelchair.
